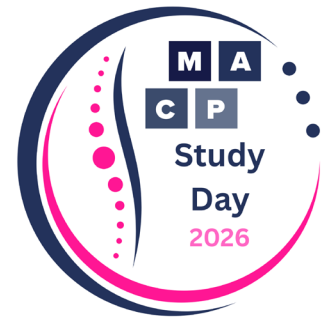

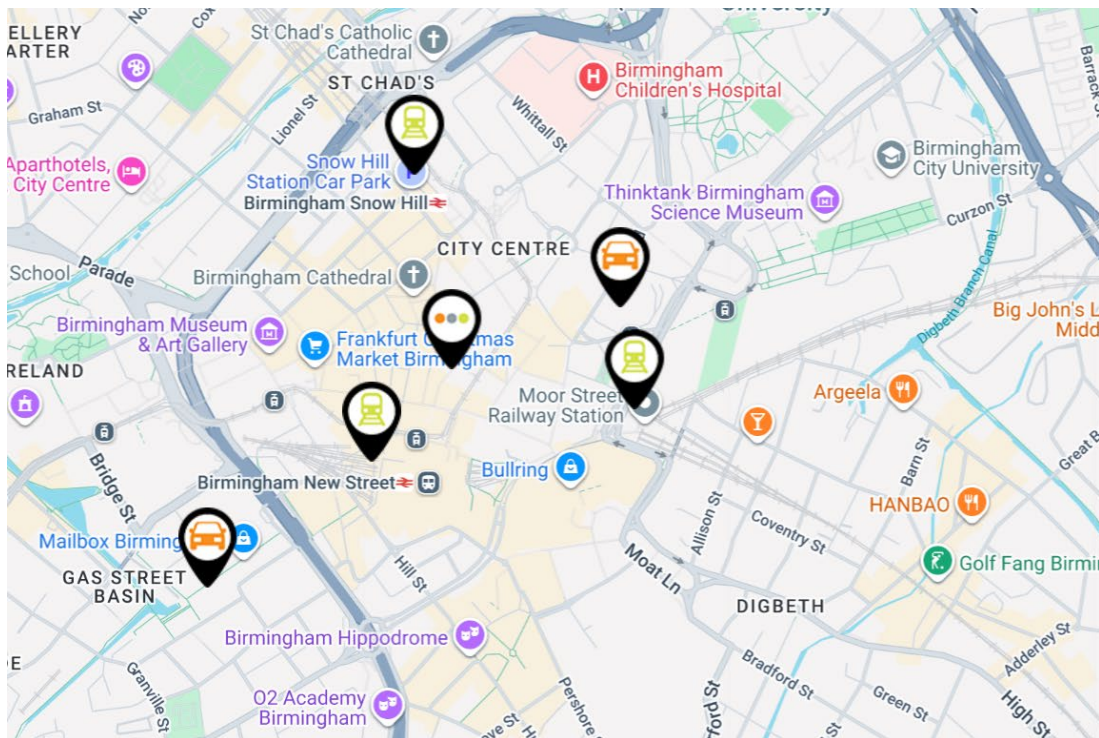
Directions to the studio:
