Overview of Year

Progress against organisation's strategic aims

- Lead, engage and influence MSK AP accreditation / standard development

The CEA and executive have worked closely with the MSK Partnership and HEE to deliver the MSK standards. These have been agreed by IFOMPT as the standards are underpinned by IFOMPT standards. Currently on the verge of publication the standards are also being used to support the HEE MSK Credential which again is being independently reviewed by IFOMPT and MACP to ensure the credential represents the MSK standards.

- Engage with HEE for credentialing and reciprocal recognition of routes to membership

This has not moved as far forward as we would have hoped however on the basis the MSK standards will be published and are IFOMPT based, then this should lead to MACP opportunities within the aim.

- Further develop the existing MACP portfolio route to include an accelerated pathway to membership

We now have passed three members through this route. We have also had publications accepted that promote portfolio routes across our pathways.

- Scope information technology capabilities to support PDC activities and CEA portfolio routes to membership.

The 14Fish portal is now fully functioning and a member benefit. Large CPD, networks are keen to work with the MACP, and it has been endorsed by the CSP and HEE.

A 3-module mentorship support CPD programme has also been completed and published. This is designed to help mentors and mentees navigate through mentored clinical practice. This was part funded through the CSP and MACP and is providing a quality standard.

Further routes to membership have been established. We are in talks with 2 HEIs regarding establishing a route.
